

# Items to Collect and Donate

### Infants

**House of Hope** (Darrell, (801)373-6562) is looking for, bedding for, diapers of all sizes, gently used children's toys, hand sanitizer, sippy cups, school supplies, rocking chairs, playground sand, and main building donations.

**Family Support and Treatment Center** (Jill, (801)229-1181). Make and donate new quilts, diapers (all sizes), wipes, baby food (jar food and rice cereal), bottles and latex gloves, music CDS, children's games, and digital cameras.

**Kids on the Move** (Kathy, (801)221-9930) is looking for tablecloths, as well as bibs with stretchy necks. Patterns can be picked up at the agency.

**The Center for Women and Children in Crisis** (Kim, (801)356-2511) is looking for diapers, baby wipes, toilet paper, and other paper products.

### Clothing

*Donate old or used clothing directly to Deseret Industries. Since Deseret Industries is equipped to store and disburse used clothing, they are the best recipient for your used items. United Way is partnered with a number of community agencies that provide vouchers that can be given to individuals in need and used toward purchases at local Deseret Industries*

### ***Bedding***

### ***Personal Hygiene***

Gather and donate hygiene kits that include hand soap, lotion, facial tissue, toilet paper, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, conditioner, combs, hairbrushes, and wash cloths. First aid items are also requested. United Way (211 or (801)377-6600) will distribute these kits to local non-profit agencies.

### ***Miscellaneous***

**The Volunteer Care Clinic** (Sarah, (801)374-8108), **Community Health Connect** (Starr, (801)818-3015) and **Mountainlands Community Health Center** (Lynn, (801)374-9660) welcome nurses, nutrition consultants and dentists to offer their services and teach health workshops to low-income families.
