

THE FOUR SEASONS

Lesson

We experience four seasons every year: spring, summer, autumn, and winter. Your child may be curious about the falling leaves during autumn and the fluffy, white, snow that comes from the sky during winter. Now is a great time to teach them about the seasons.



Outing

Go for a walk around the neighborhood point out characteristics of the season you are experiencing currently. Examples include newly blooming flower and blossoms in spring, hot sunshine in summer, leaves changing colors in autumn, and snow in winter.

Arts & Crafts

Making snowmen (2+ years)

Materials: Construction paper, cotton balls, glue, and crayons.

Description: Paste cotton balls on the paper to resemble a snowman and decorate him and the surroundings as you please.

Snack Time

Ingredients: Apples and caramel dipping sauce.
Directions: Wash the apples and slice them into several pieces and serve with a premade caramel dipping sauce.



Activity & Games

Playing outside (Suitable for all ages)
