Books for Under Age 3

Made of durable materials: cardboard, plastic, washable cloth, Appeal to senses, Big, bright colors or familiar objects, Books in the native language of the caregiver maybe helpful

Books for Ages 3-5

Illustrations are clear and colorful, Simple to somewhat complex plots that can be read in one sitting, Rhymes and repetition, Reviews letters, numbers, shapes, colors

Books for Ages 6-11

Clear, easy to read text, Colorful pictures that give clues to meaning of unfamiliar words, Early readers or chapter books that can be read over several days, Books by the same author or with characters they enjoy

Books for Ages 12 and up

Help child cope with daily challenges or characters are going through similar experiences, Genres they are interested in, Other books could be: logic puzzles, trivia books or graphic novels
